

Plant Labels

Supplies

White flannel lined vinal.

Cut-away-stabilizer.

Sticks (I purchased ½ inch wide flat bamboo 16-inch-long sticks from amazon (Worown 60 pcs 15.7 Inch Strong Natural Bamboo Sticks \$9.99 for 60 sticks) You can use any stick and length that works for you.

Instructions

Hoop 1 layer of flannel lined vinal and 1 layer of cut-away stabilizer.

(Vinal on top)

(I used a vinal flannel backed tablecloth, can find often at goodwill type store or fabric store

Sew out pattern, trim close to the edges.

Fold in ½ wrong sides together

Zigzag a border around the edge starting at the bottom leaving room for the stick to go in. I sewed the border edge twice just to make it more secure.

Push a stick into the bottom opening and measure from the inside to almost the bottom of the label with the stick so you know where to put the glue on the stick. Add glue then slip it in the bottom opening and line the stick up in the center. I put a clip on the top end till the glue dried.

Use a vase or a tall glass to put the finished labels in till the glue is totally dry.

Sweet and simple, completed in minutes and awaiting your garden.
