


From The Needle Of: Anne



TatChe Antique

Free Standing Lace Border Set Samples

- Tested using 2 sheets of fabric like wss along with fine toole.
- Use 12 point needle
- Thread Recommended: 40 weight thread and serger thread in bobbin if your machine likes it, or use the same 40 wt. thread in the bobbin.
- Designs were created with Embird and were sewn on Kenmore 19001 4x4 hoop, tested in sew format.
- Do not resize these designs in any way, as you will loose stitch quality.
- You may rotate, and mirror designs , Combine designs to fill your hoop.
- Slow machine down if necessary.

Tip: It is recommended that you clean your bobbin area and replace your needle often. Start with a fresh needle.

- Gather your Supplies

Fabric Like WSS, Toole, Thread colors of your choice, bobbins, needles, pins, small scissors, ribbons if desired.



- After stitching lace to item, rinsing and drying ...ribbons may be weaved through loop edges in lace.

	<p>TatChe Antique Sample ...1 color lace Stitch in any color you like 1041 stitches 32.7 x 19.6 mm</p>
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	<p>TatChe Square 4499 stitches 49.2 x 49.3mm 2 colors (use the same thread)</p>
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
<p>Set up pattern template,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hoop 2 layers wss, along with toole. Keep wss and toole straight, wrinkle free. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stitch the 1st stitch, • Remove hoop, trim away toole from the outside, replace hoop and continue stitching.

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*Stitch as many as you like .
Trim away excess wss.*

*To attach to fabric, follow straight edges,
I used a straight stitch and then followed with a
lightening stitch.*



*Finish project, soak in water to remove wss.
Hand cleaning recommended.*
