INFORMATION

5x7 ITH design

Design done in one hooping

Stitch count 3,653

Finished size 5 x 16 (2 inch x 6.1/4 inch)

SUPPLIES LIST

- Water soluble stabilizer (not the plastic kind)
- Compressed batting

- Same colour thread in bobbin and top of machine to match main fabric
- Main fabric
- Contrasting fabric
- Towel (this holder can be fitted to any size and type of towel)

ITH (IN THE HOOP) DESIGNS HAVE MULTIPLE LAYERS OF FABRIC & BATTING. MAKE SURE YOUR FABRIC IS THIN AND NOT A THICK FABRIC LIKE DENIM OR VINYL. IF THE DESIGN STIPULATES THE USE OF THICK FABRIC OR VINYL THE STEPS TO ADJUST THE THICKNESS IS INCORPORATED INTO THE DESIGN. IF YOU SHOULD MAKE A CHOICE AND USE A THICK FABRIC OR VINYL JUST LEAVE OUT THE COMPRESSED BATTING. DO NOT USE ANY THICK FABRIC WHEN YOU ARE PLEATING AS IN THE CARD SLOTS IN THE PURSE AND WALLET DESIGNS. WHEN YOU USE THE CORRECT CHOICES OF MATERIALS THE DESIGN WILL SEW OUT PROPERLY AND THERE WILL BE NO UNDUE STRESS ON YOUR MACHINE

1 x Compressed batting 8cm x 14cm

1 x Contrasting fabric 8cm x 19cm

1 x Main fabric 8cm x 19cm

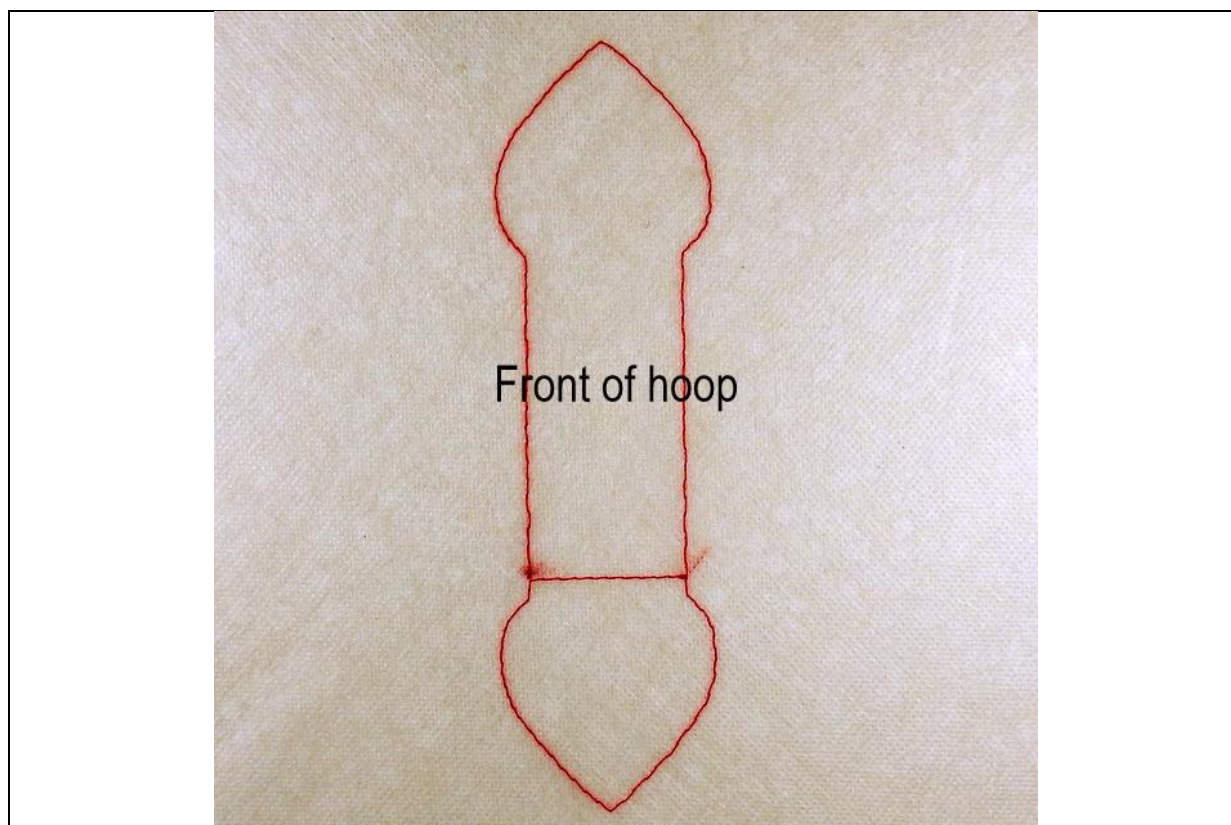

TIPS & INSTRUCTION INFORMATION

1. It is best to read the INSTRUCTIONS before you sew
2. **ITH (IN THE HOOP) DESIGNS HAVE MULTIPLE LAYERS OF FABRIC & BATTING. MAKE SURE YOUR FABRIC IS THIN AND NOT A THICK FABRIC LIKE DENIM OR VINYL. IF THE DESIGN STIPULATES THE USE OF THICK FABRIC OR VINYL THE STEPS TO ADJUST THE THICKNESS IS INCORPORATED INTO THE DESIGN. IF YOU SHOULD MAKE A CHOICE AND USE A THICK FABRIC OR VINYL JUST LEAVE OUT THE COMPRESSED BATTING. DO NOT USE ANY THICK FABRIC WHEN YOU ARE PLEATING AS IN THE CARD SLOTS IN THE PURSE AND WALLET DESIGNS. WHEN YOU USE THE CORRECT CHOICES OF MATERIALS THE DESIGN WILL SEW OUT PROPERLY AND THERE WILL BE NO UNDUE STRESS ON YOUR MACHINE**
3. The instructions will stipulate and guide you as to where the right and wrong side of the fabric should be facing in accordance with the stabilizer. For example if the instruction says place the fabric with the right side or wrong side FACING the STABILIZER on the top of the hoop or UNDER the hoop then you do just that
4. Sewing STEPS in the PDF Instructions do not coincide with the sewing STEPS of the design. The bullets in each STEP of the PDF instructions can either be a sewing step, cutting step, placing of fabric step etc
5. Use colour THREAD to match your fabric. Most of the patterns requires only one colour thread. I use the same colour thread on the top & in the bobbin
6. FABRIC sizes are stipulated in the instructions. What colour fabric you use is your choice
7. Many of the COLOUR STOPS in the pattern are for step changes
8. CUT OFF excess fabric or batting as close as possible to zigzag or stitching mean just that. Cut as close as you can even if you snip the zigzag or batting stitches. Don't worry because it will not effect the end result. However if you don't cut off excess fabric & batting properly at the said stage it will stick out of your final satin stitching and have a scruffy finish
9. DO NOT REMOVE YOUR WORK OUT OF THE HOOP TILL IT IS COMPLETED
10. Once you have completed a panel only cut the larger unwanted threads with a scissor and then singe gently with a lighter flame the fluffy unwanted threads. Don't hold the flame too long against the panel because they will burn)
11. If you have detected an error in my PDF Instructions or I have not

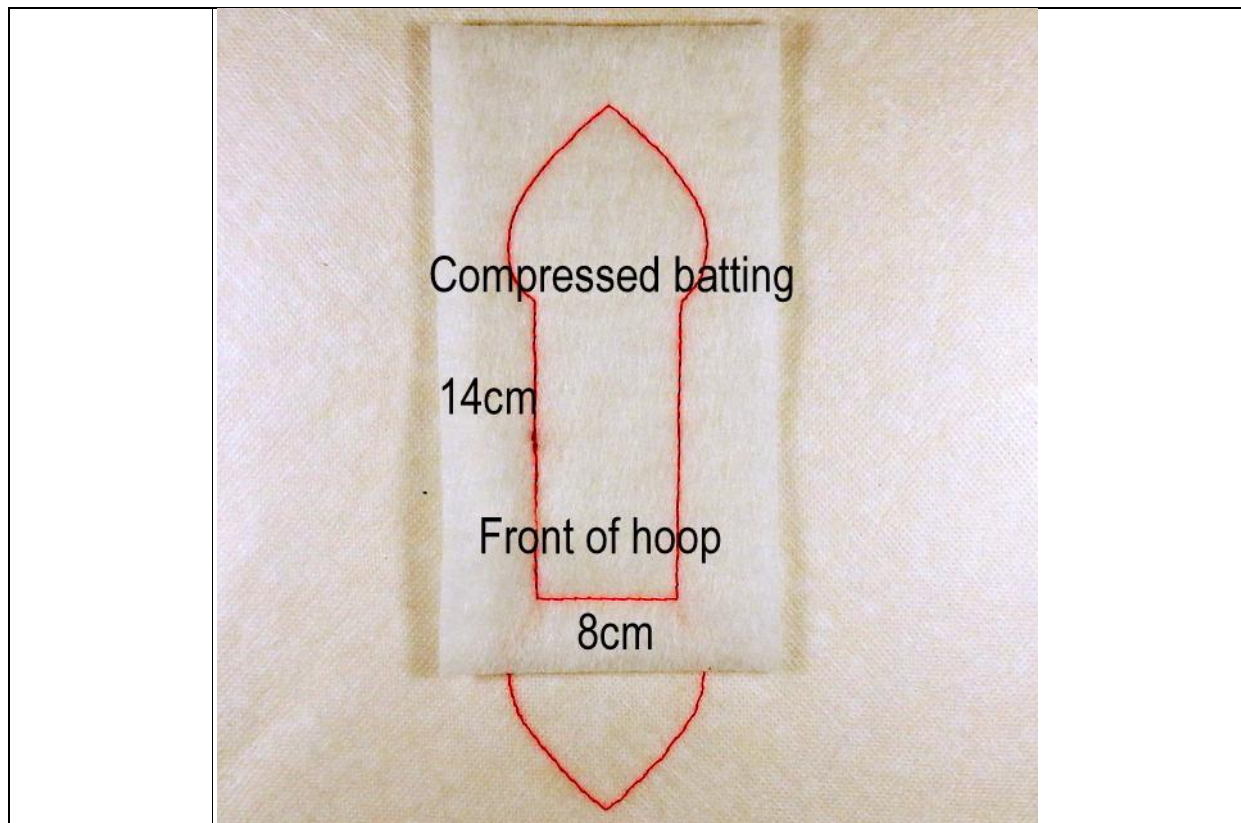

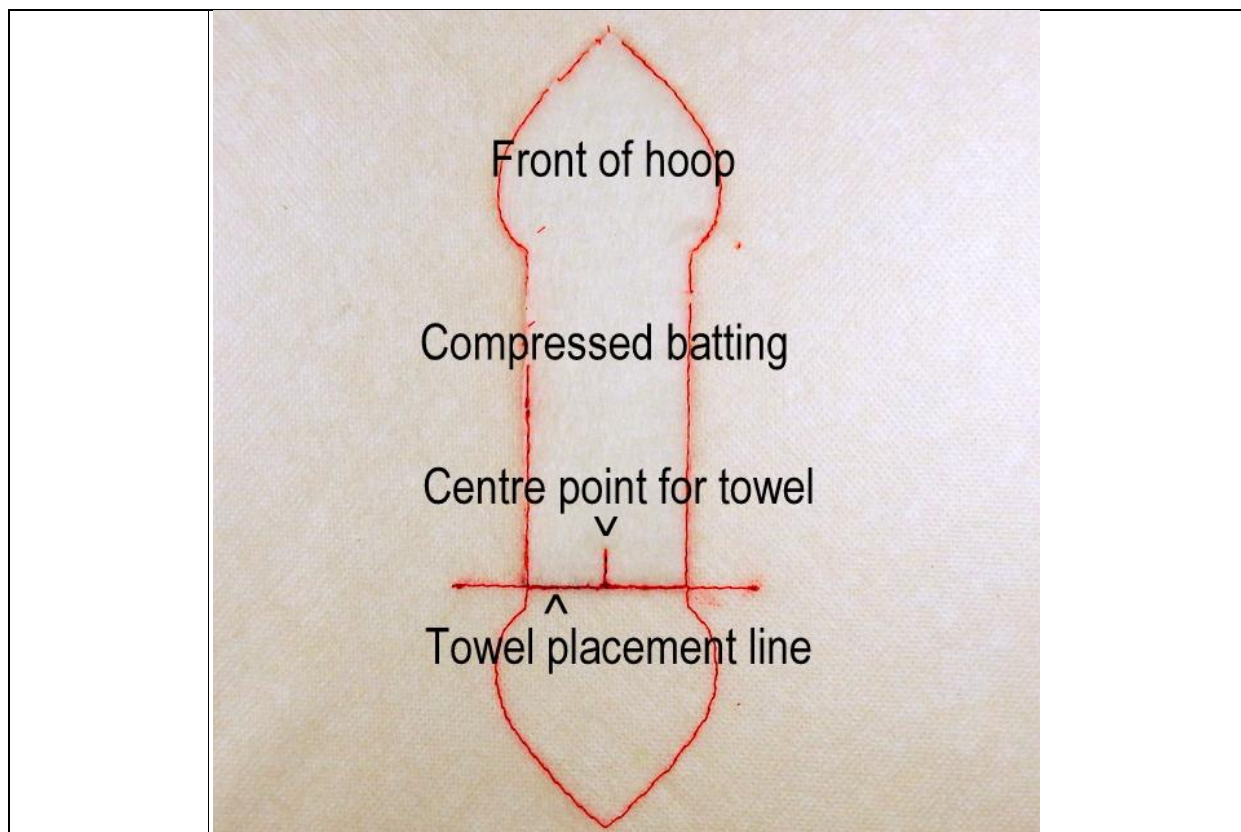
Step 1:

- Place water soluble stabilizer in hoop and sew placement area for towel holder
- The top section of the holder is the placement area for the compressed batting



Step 2:

- Place compressed batting over the batting placement area of the holder on the front of the hoop
- Tape down batting so that it does not shift or pucker when stitched down
- Stitch down batting



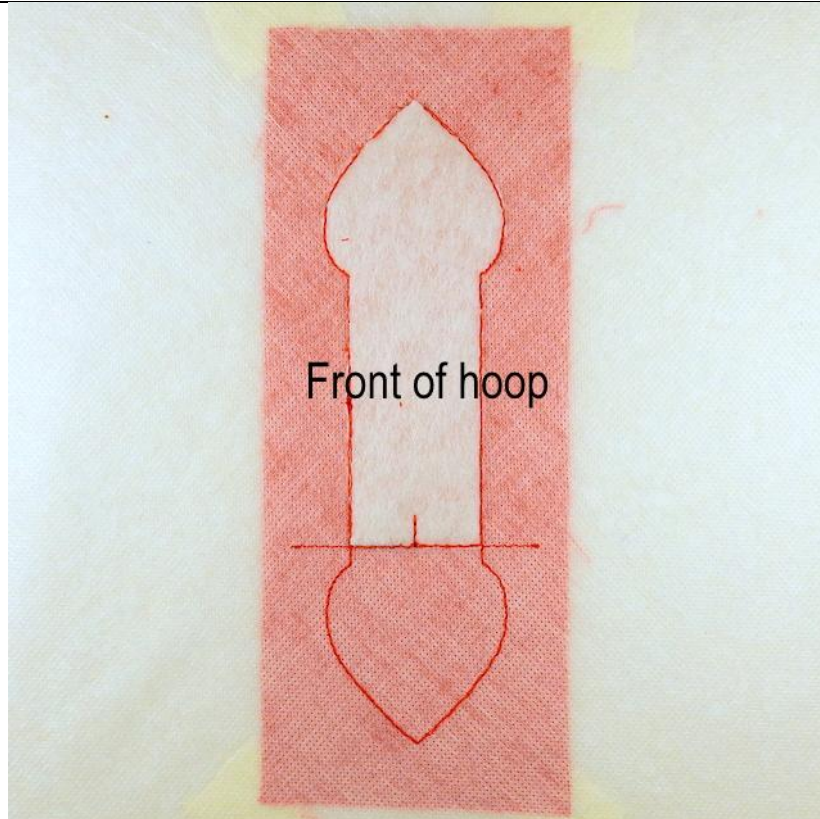
Step 3:

- Cut off excess compressed batting close to the stitching
- Sew towel placement/centre point line

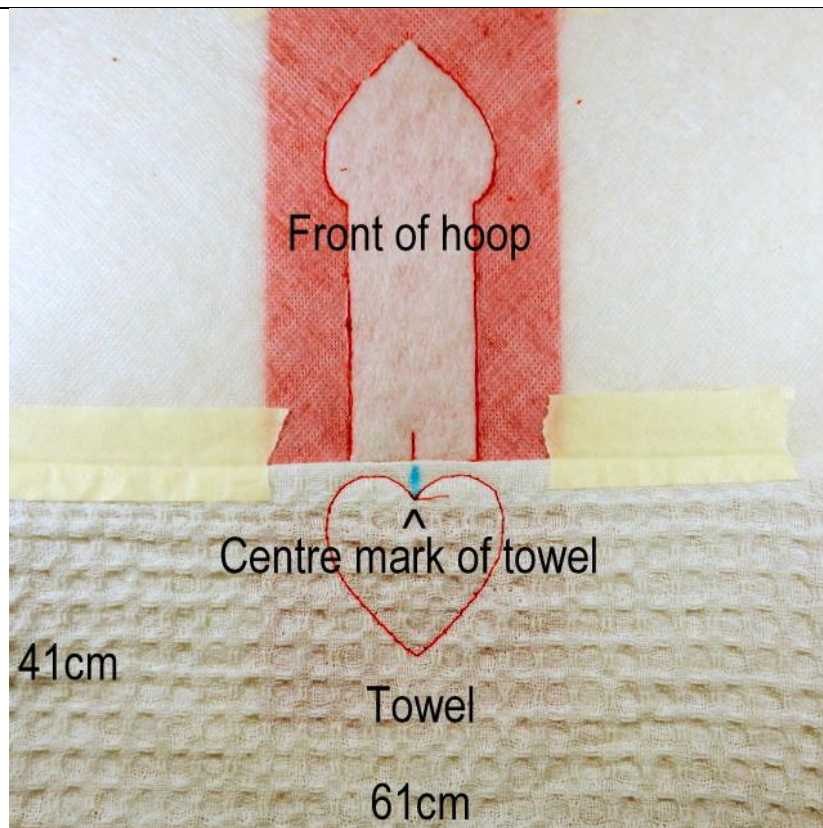


Step 4:

- Place contrasting fabric over the whole holder on the back of the hoop
- Right side of contrasting fabric facing away from stabilizer
- Tape down contrasting fabric so that it does not shift or pucker when stitched down
- Stitch down contrasting fabric

Step 5:

- Mark the centre of the towel on the length and **NOT THE WIDTH** of the towel
- I have given measurements of a towel I used for this design. You can use any towel and size you wish
- Place the centre mark on the towel on the centre mark of the placement line on the front of the hoop
- At the same time line up the edge of the towel along the horizontal placement line
- Right side of towel facing away from the stabilizer
- Tape down the towel so that it does not shift or pucker when stitched down
- Stitch down towel with the heart



Step 6:

- Place main fabric over the whole holder on the front of the hoop
- Right side of main fabric facing away from stabilizer
- Tape down main fabric so that it does not shift or pucker when stitched down
- Stitch down main fabric
- Sew popper placement areas

- Zigzag holder



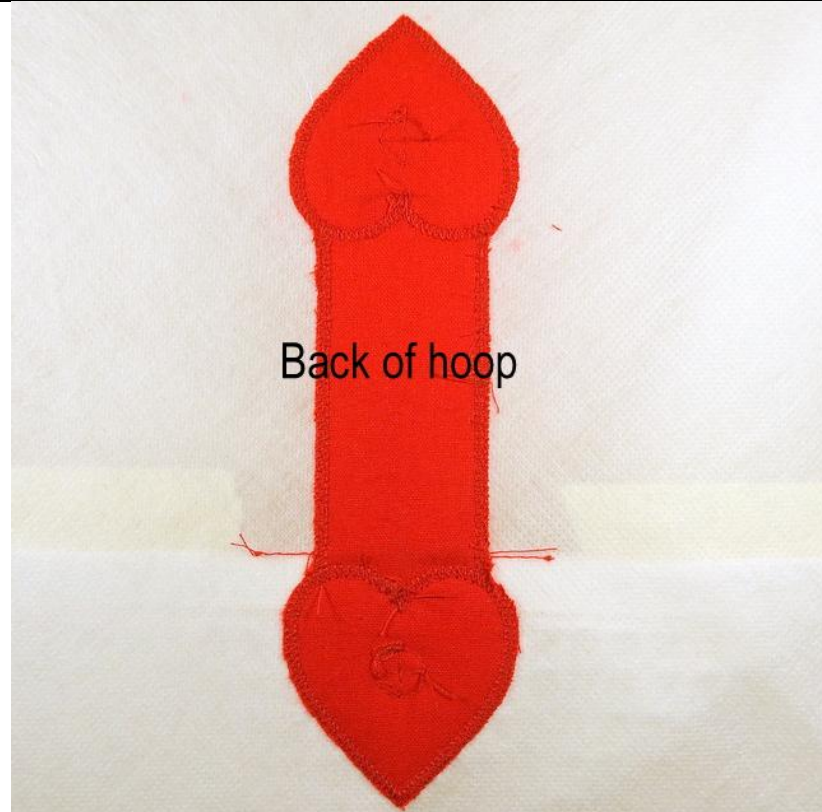
Back of hoop

Step 8:

- Cut off excess fabric from the front and back of hoop close to zigzag stitching

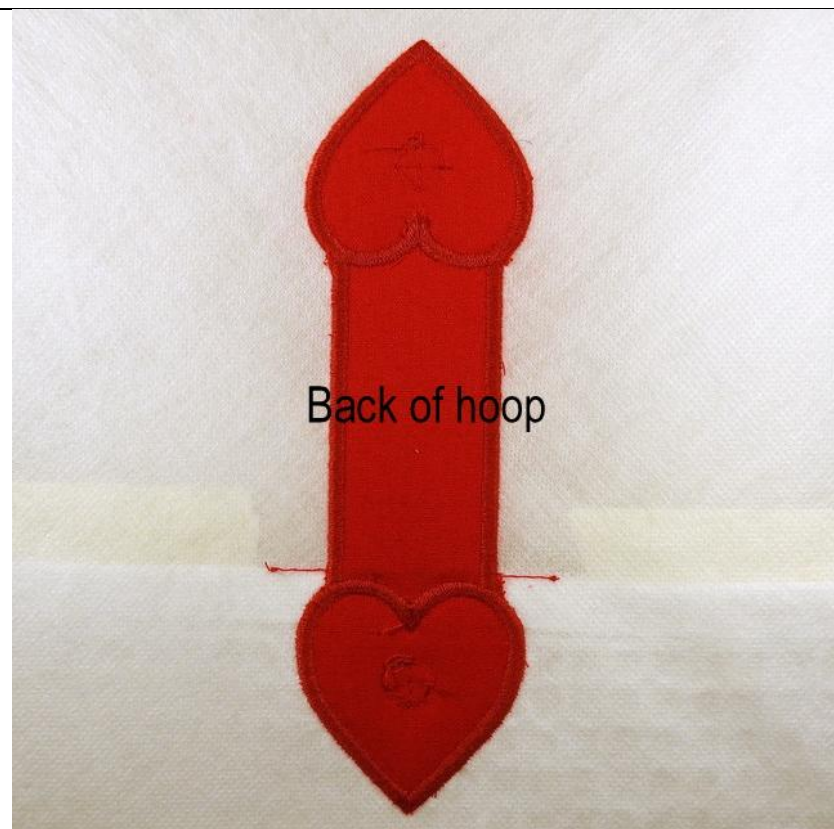


BACK OF HOOP VIEW



Step 9:

- Statin stitch holder

Step 10:

- Attach popper pieces to the two popper placement areas
- You can also use stitch on poppers, hole punch poppers and even hand stitch on velcro



The Heart Towel Holder can be attached to any make of towel and size. The loop is large enough to fit the standard size towel rails and oven handles. Enjoy!
