APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. "APPLIQUE POSITION" is a straight guide stitch to indicate where to place your fabric for the appliqué.
- 2. Place fabric over the indicated area.
- 3. "APPLIQUE FABRIC" then sews the fabric down.
- 4. Cut away the excess fabric without removing the embroidery from the hoop.
- 5. Continue with the embroidery of the design.

Use the same colour for the "APPLIQUE POSITION", "APPLIQUE FABRIC" and "FINAL OUTLINE" where possible to co-ordinate with colour of fabric used for appliqué.

Block 1 - Ladybug

92.1 x 75.2mm (3.63 x 2.96"); 4 455 Stitches 9 Thread Changes

- 1. Ladybug backside.
- 2. APPLIQUE POSITION of ladybug wings.
- 3. APPLIQUE FABRIC of ladybug wings.
- 4. Black spots of the wings.
- 5. White spots on body.
- 6. FINAL OUTLINE of ladybug wings.
- 7. Ladybug head.
- 8. White spots on head.
- 9. Ladybug's tentacles.
- 10. Add beads at the end of the tentacles.
