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## APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. "APPLIQUE POSITION" is a straight quide stitch to indicate where to place your fabric for the appliqué.
- 2. Place fabric over the indicated area.
- 3. "APPLIQUE FABRIC" then sews the fabric down.
- 4. Cut away the excess fabric without removing the embroidery from the hoop.
- 5. Continue with the embroidery of the design.

Use the same colour for the "APPLIQUE POSITION", "APPLIQUE FABRIC" and "FINAL OUTLINE" where possible to co-ordinate with colour of fabric used for appliqué.

6 inches: 150 x 149.4mm (5.91 x 5.88"); 18 616 Stitches 7 inches: 180 x 180mm (7.09 x 7.09"); 23 012 Stitches 8 inches: 200 x 199.8mm (8.00 x 7.99"); 27 311 Stitches

13 Thread Changes

Marathon Rayon colours listed

- 1. Hoop background fabric (Teal) and pin batting to the back of the hoop or float stabiliser underneath.
- 2. Colour 1: APPLIQUE POSITION (Light Purple) Violet Tulip 1260
- 3. Colour 2: APPLIQUE FABRIC (Light Purple) Violet Tulip 1260
- 4. Remove hoop from machine and trim fabric around outside of circle.
- 5. Colour 3: APPLIQUE POSITION (White) of blades. White 1179
- 6. Colour 4: APPLIQUE FABRIC of blades and centre. White 1179
- Remove hoop from machine and trim fabric around outside of stitching.
  Cut away the first (White) and second (Purple) layer of fabric inside small centre circle to uncover the background fabric.
- 8. Colour 5: APPLIQUE POSITION (Dark Pink). Cherry Blossom 1025
- 9. Colour 6: APPLIQUE FABRIC (Dark Pink). Cherry Blossom 1025
- 10. Remove hoop from machine and trim fabric around outside of stitching.
- 11. Colour 7: FINAL OUTLINE (Dark Pink). Cherry Blossom 1025
- 12. Continue stitching:

Colour 8: *Canary Yellow* 1007 Colour 9: *Mint Julep* 1093 Colour 10: *Violet Tulip 1260* 

Colour 11: Cherry Blossom 1025

- 13. FINAL OUTLINE of White areas and outside circle. White 1179
- 14. Add backing to the back of the embroidery.
- 15. Colour 13: Stitch outline of block in coordinating colour.
- 16. Cut 1/4" from Colour 13 to allow for seam allowance.
